



Yinka's Coco Challenge



This list gives clubs, areas, and the district concrete, ready-to-run fundraising ideas built around Yinka's Coco Challenge theme, scaled from a single club activity to a district-wide push, with World Polio Day, Oct 24, 2026, as the rallying date. These events are suggestions only, to be tailored to the needs & requirements of individual clubs / areas and district.

1. Rotary Club Level

- **"Change for Coco" jars:** Simple coin/bill jars at club meetings and partner businesses, topped off weekly and totalled toward the club's Oct 24 goal.
- **Vaccine-drop challenge:** Members pledge a dollar amount per "drop" — a nod to the End Polio Now vaccine-drop symbol — collected at each meeting between now and Oct 24.
- **Club Coco silent auction:** Auction a numbered/signed Coco plush at a regular meeting or social; low-effort, high-visibility, easy to repeat club to club. (NB: be sure to contact a member of the "Coco Team" in order to ensure your Coco is ready for this event.
- **Coco raffle:** Sell tickets for a chance to win a Coco plush or small prize pack; simple, works for clubs with limited event capacity.
- **Fundraiser meal:** A pancake breakfast, BBQ, or dinner where a portion (or all) of ticket price goes to the campaign, branded with Yinka's Coco table signage and a QR code to the pledge wall.
- **Kids' Coco colouring contest:** Small entry-fee contest for members' kids/grandkids or a partner school class, ties the campaign to families.
- **"Adopt-a-Coco" photo tour:** A member "hosts" Coco for a week, posts a photo with a short note on why they support ending polio, then passes Coco to the next member with a small pledge attached.

2. Area Level Fundraising Opportunities

- **Area "Coco Cup":** Inter-club fundraising competition tracked on a shared leaderboard, with a trophy or travelling Coco awarded at the next area assembly.
- **"Steps to End Polio" walk/run:** A joint area walk or fun run culminating on Oct 24, funded through entry fees and per-kilometre pledges.
- **Area trivia or games night:** Ticketed event with tables sponsored by clubs or local businesses; a Rotary/polio-history round ties it back to the cause.
- **Combined area auction:** Each club contributes an item or experience; the original hand-crafted Coco (or a special-edition plush) anchors the evening as the marquee lot.



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- **Area golf tournament or similar:** Hole/table sponsorships sold to local businesses, proceeds rolled into the area's Oct 24 total.
